



BEEGEES

GOALKEEPER, Adrian Frizzo, 23: Came through Beegees junior ranks to take over from two of Coast's best keepers Alan Smerdon and Mick Poulitsas and is now regular representative player. Has the advantage of playing behind a top defence but is more than capable of cleaning up at the back. Surprisingly agile for his size.

FULLBACK, Pat Collins, 24: Also a Beegees junior product, a tenacious tackler and speedy player who likes to overlap. Has moved his way up into the first division team this season from reserve grade. Playing alongside Curtis and Giles can only lift his game.

FULLBACK, Chris Hall, 18: Formerly with Maroochydore, has played for Coast and Wide Bay at junior level and Coast at senior level. Shows great on-field maturity for a teenager and has shown in colts appearances he can come forward to attack.

FULLBACK, Stephen Wendt, 18: Non-stop player who represented Coast and Wide Bay juniors and has gone ahead in leaps and bounds by playing alongside the first division players.

SWEEPER, Alan Curtis, 33: An astute reader of the game who can play any position. Has dazzled his opponents from midfield for most of the season but moved back to sweeper in the finals with great effect. Played all his junior soccer in England before stints with Polonia and North Brisbane and now a regular Coast player.

STOPPER, Tom Giles, 29: Captain. A safe defender who played all his soccer in Brisbane, including North Brisbane where he teamed with Curtis, before switching to Caboolture and Beegees from where he has represented the Coast.

MIDFIELD, Phil Shaw, 27: One of the longest-serving Beegees players who has never been with another club. A rugged and aggressive player who has risen from Beegees junior teams to the senior Coast side.

MIDFIELD, Gary Carless, 17: Queensland under 18 representative, former Reds State League player who has also played for Maroochydore and Reds juniors. Also plays colts. A great prospect who has good ball skills and ability to play most positions.

UTILITY, Gordon Wendt, 24: Brother of Steve Wendt. Another home-grown player who works hard and uses his speed to good effect during the game. Has represented the Coast at junior and senior level.

MIDFIELD, Warren Whisson, 22: Fast and deadly accurate, came to the club last year with coach Bevan Chantler after playing for Grange Thistle, Redcliffe, Pine Rivers and Brisbane City before Beegees. Coast representative.

FORWARD, Ian Brown, 21: Genuine ball player at his best when running wide. Previous clubs include Caloundra, Nambour Reds State League team.

FORWARD, David Payne, 20: Former State under 16 representative who played all his junior soccer with Caboolture. Has plenty of speed and never knows when he is beaten.

FORWARD, Jay Larkin, 32: Deceptive player whose ball skills have not deteriorated over the years. He usually sets up rather than scores goals. Played national league in New Zealand.

FORWARD, Danny Sinclair, 28: A quiet but dour and very fit Scot in first season with Beegees. Has mainly played with the reserves team this season and displays the typically British ball-playing style.

UTILITY, David White, 23: Beegees junior product and junior Coast representative. Elusive and plays his best when given space.
